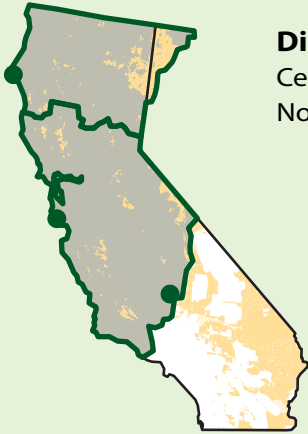

Description: This project rehabilitates and repairs three historic sites to improve visitor education and enjoyment. The deferred maintenance repairs and preservation of the historic Punta Gorda Light Station, Walker Cabin, and Cotoni-Coast Dairies cheese barn will provide historically accurate repairs that are essential to provide safe conditions for the visiting public. Performing overdue repairs to these unique and irreplaceable historic structures will allow the BLM to focus on routine maintenance going forward.

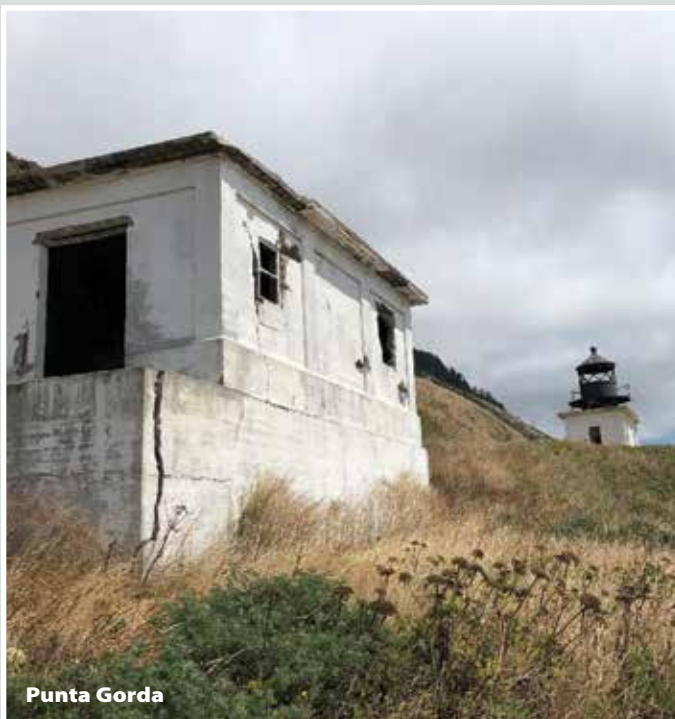
